Dear ISPA Parents:

Your child's testing information for the month of May is now available and can be found on the school website [www.ispa.dadeschools.net](http://www.ispa.dadeschools.net) and on their grade-level Teams Class created by Ms. Acevedo. All students, whether PHY or MSO, must report to ISPA physically to take their exam(s). In order to maintain safety and to adhere to CDC guidelines, the following procedures have been put in place:

- All computer keyboards and mice are covered with a plastic protection wrapping and will be replaced after each session.
- All computer labs and classrooms will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected each day.
- Hand sanitizer is available for use in all classrooms.
- Students and teachers will maintain social distance during testing.
- All students coming to ISPA to test must wear with their ISPA polo or "I AM ISPA" shirt with jeans or khaki uniform pants, and mask during all testing sessions.

There will be **two mandatory MSO weeks** on May 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> and May 10<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>. This means that all non-testing students will be at home.

During these weeks, students will log into their first period for attendance and teachers will post asynchronous assignments in their Teams Classrooms for students to complete independently while testing is taking place that day.

- During MSO weeks, lunch will be from 11:10 am – 11:40 am for MSO students. For those testing, it will be dependent on when students are finished with their session
- All parents must fill out the online dismissal form for their child. The links for the forms can be found on the school website and grade-level Teams Classes.
  - Morning AM test sessions:
    - Arrival time is 7:20 am sharp.
    - Dismissal time will depend on the exam being taken.
  - Afternoon PM test sessions:
    - Arrival time is 11:30 am sharp.
    - Dismissal time will depend on the exam being taken.
- Students must bring their own pen and pencil, and headphones (if applicable) to use.
- Students may bring their ISPA sweater, a water bottle, and snack.
